RIDE FOR BIKES - 2024

- On 19 May, 22 cyclists took part in our *Ride for Bikes* and rode 50km around Pt Noarlunga / McLaren Vale.
- 150 donors responded to their appeal and helped to raise \$17,500.
- This – plus a top-up from the general program budget – enabled NoBarriers to purchase 68 sturdy bikes at a total cost of \$21,000 from our partner in Zimbabwe, [World Bicycle Relief](#) (WBR).
- [WBR](#) donated another 22 bikes.
- 2 months later, on 19 July, a total of 90 bikes were distributed to 1st year students at Muzarabani High (51 bikes) and Hwata Secondary (39) Schools.

To qualify for a bike, students have to live a minimum of 6km away from school.

- Riding on bikes to school is expected to reduce the commute time for these 90 lucky students by 70%. This will save a student on average 2.8 hours a day, 14 hours a week and 560 hours per school year – a lot of time, they now can spend on homework, sport and play 😊.

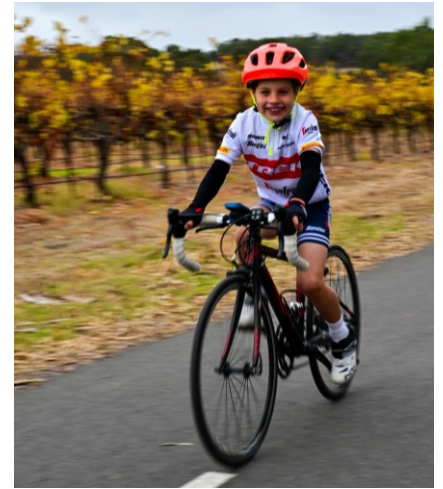
