RIDE FOR BIKES - 2025

- On 6 April, 25 cyclists took part in our *Ride for Bikes* and rode 50km around Pt Noarlunga / McLaren Vale.
- 205 donors responded to their appeal and helped to raise \$20,000.
- This – plus a top-up from our general program budget – enabled NoBarriers to purchase 68 sturdy bikes at a total cost of \$21,989 from Buffalo Bicycles, The Zimbabwean branch of our partner, [World Bicycle Relief](#) (WBR).
- [WBR](#) / Buffalo Bicycles donated another 22 bikes.
- 4 months later, on 5th August, a total of 90 bikes were distributed to 1st year students at Muzarabani High and Hwata Secondary Schools. Each school received 45 bikes.

To qualify for a bike, students have to live a minimum of 6km away from school.

- Riding on bikes to school will reduce average commute time for these 90 lucky students by more than 2.5 hours. This will save a student 560 hours per school year – a lot of time, they now can spend on homework, sport and play.
